MINUTES OF JUNE 27, 2014

The June 27, 2014 meeting of the Madison Township Supervisors was called to order by Claire Swartz at 3:00 PM. Attending were, Claire Swartz, Glenn Titman, Michelle Densberger, and Peggy Long.

RECOGNITION OF GUESTS

OPENNING OF BIDS FOR BACKHOE

Two bids were received:

1. Highway Equipment & Supply from Drums, PA in the amount of \$95,520.00,
2. J.L. Hollinger & Sons, Inc. from Manheim, PA in the amount of \$37,000.00.

Bids were reviewed.

Michelle Densberger made a motion to accept the bid from J.L. Hollinger & Sons, Inc. in the amount of \$37,000.00 delivered. Glenn Titman seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Michelle Densberger recommended financing \$30,000.00 and taking \$7,000.00 from the budget. We have budgeted \$20,000.00 for major equipment. The truck and backhoe could be paid off in three years.

Glenn Titman made a motion to adopt Resolution #06272014 to enter into a Municipal Lease Agreement with option to purchase with the First Columbia Bank at a rate of 2.3%. Michelle Densberger seconded the motion. Motion carried.

OTHER BUSINESS

Glenn Titman spoke with Steve Cuzior from DEP concerning the oil spill in Jerseytown near Tri-County Farm Equipment. DEP asked if we would be willing to take the backhoe and load the contaminated dirt into our truck on plastic. Glenn wasn't sure what we would do with the dirt then. The one property owner is deceased and the other is in a nursing home. Michelle Densberger would like a letter from DEP with everything spelled out in it, so we know exactly what we would be responsible for before we consider doing the cleanup. If it were another property owner, they would be responsible. Claire Swartz noted it can be put on tarps and let stand for a period of time, but then we would have to dispose of it. Michelle noted there would be cost of labor and equipment on us if we clean it up. Glenn Titman questioned if a judgment could be put on the property if we had expenses. Michelle wasn't sure how that would work. Michelle will contact Steve for more information. Table until July meeting.

Michelle Densberger noted Ted Stout did receive the letter. He advised her verbally that he had traded the guns and D&R Sporting. Michelle has a call in the ATF for verification. She also feels Ted Stout should respond to the Township in writing.
