RECOGNITION OF GUESTS

MINUTES

Peggy Long presented the minutes of October 13, 2014. *Michelle Densberger made a motion to accept the minutes of October 13, 2014. Glenn Titman seconded the motion. Motion carried.*

FINANCIAL REPORTS

The financial statements and bills were reviewed.

Michelle Densberger made a motion to approve the financial reports and to pay bills as presented. Bills paid from General Fund were \$2,416.25. Bills paid from Liquid Fuel Fund were \$3,196.42. Bills paid during the month from the General Fund totaled \$2,313.85. Bills paid during the month from the Liquid Fuel Fund totaled \$111.40. Glenn Titman seconded the motion. Motion carried.

MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY

Nancy Welliver reported the Municipal Authority had approved the 2015 but noted it is very tight. The Authority Member moved to raise the monthly rate from \$42.00 to \$45.00 per unit.

Michelle Densberger reviewed a proposed subdivision for Crissman. Columbia County Planning Commission asked the building setback be changed and noted a driveway permit will be needed. County approved pending changes. *Glenn Titman made a motion to accept revised Crissman subdivision. Michelle Densberger seconded the motion.*
